

****KIRKISTOWN CIRCUIT INFO Saturday 2nd September 2017****

The circuit will be open from 4pm on FRIDAY 1st September & Gates will be CLOSED at 10.30pm and no further Entrance / Departing the circuit will be permitted. Gates will provisionally reopen at 6.30am on SATURDAY Morning.

Competitor's vehicles will be parked in the paddock on a first come first serve basis. Any non race vehicles will NOT be permitted into the paddock.

All Competitors are reminded to be considerate and remember generators MUST be turned off no later than 11pm - This is to reduce noise pollution in the area of and around the circuit. Failure to comply with instructions given by the Paddock / Club staff may result in the rider (s) exclusion from the event.

Electricity for those staying from the Friday evening will be approx. £10 - £15 and the 500 Club personnel will be collecting the money for this.

Note: Electricity is for sole use of the purchaser. IE not to be linked to others

We have been informed by the Owners of Kirkistown that due to an ongoing issue the electricity output in the garages is reduced. Competitors are advised to bring their own generators. This is nothing to do with the B & D club.

Power leads are not to be run from garages to outside vehicles at any time

As normal Garages can be booked via the 500 Club.

Scrutineering will take place on Friday evening from 7pm-8.30pm. Rider sign on will also be open 7.00pm - 8.45pm.

Scrutineering Saturday morning will take place from approx. 07.30am - 09.00am

Rider sign on will be open from 07.15 until 09.00 approx.

Remember to get scrutineered first and bring docket(s) to sign on.

A Rider briefing will take place at the podium at the base of the control tower at 08.35 - All Competitor attendance is COMPULSORY.

Please also remember to join us at the Podium presentations at the base of the control tower, immediately after the last race.

Rider access is by main gate where entrant names will be marked a off gate list- each rider is limited to three persons (including entrant) everyone else must pay.

Spectator admission is £10 which includes an event programme. Children under 12yrs are free and must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
